

MT TAM MINI-QUILT PROJECT DAY

Friday, July 25 @ Picket Fence Quilts in Novato
Led by Nancy Reck

No pattern will be supplied for this project day, so each quilt will be unique. Bring a photo, a sketch, or just an idea of something that you'd like to make that will suggest a view of Mt. Tam. The quilts should be about 9" x 12", or even postcard size; we're trying to keep them small and therefore affordable. Whatever technique you want to use in making your quilt will be fine; we want to appeal to varied tastes. I've done a lot of landscape quilts, so though this won't be a teaching workshop, I'll be there to give you guidance and help if you need it.



Supplies:

- Assorted fabrics to create your scene; you might want to bring some extra fabric to swap with others
- Batting and backing fabric large enough for your project. The quilts will be finished pillowcase style, unless you prefer to bind.
- Fusible material such as Wonder Under
- Threads for piecing and for top-stitching/quilting
- Sewing machine with piecing, walking and, if you're so inclined, free-motion feet.
- Rotary cutter and mat large enough for your piece
- Small amount of Steam-a-Seam 2, to close up your pillowcase
- Scissors, large and small, and just to be safe, a seam ripper
- Any extras you might want to add, such as fibers, ribbons, or embellishments
